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
Model of Declaration

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- **Cage No.1** - Whether Import or Export
- Select from EX 1,2 or 3 (Depending on the Customs Procedure Codes)
 - EX 1 – Direct permanent Export
 - EX 2 – Temporary Export
 - EX 3 – Re-export
- For Import
 - IM 4 – Direct Import
 - IM 5 –
 - IM 6 ,7,8,9
- Depending on the model of declaration mandatory fields in the CusDec are activated

Tea Exports

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- Normally declarations are prepared, submitted and assessed by the importer/exporter themselves
- But for Tea Exporters we advice not to assess (**do not** click icon “validate and assess”)
- This is because they have to get the clearance from the Tea Board prior to processing of the CusDec
- First fill the exports CusDec and then click on the blue icon (validate) near the  icon.
- Then you will get a mail stating the assessment No. for that CusDec

Tea Exports

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- This is the number that you have to put on the Blend Sheet
- For Tea Board reference a “**Blend Sheet**” should be submitted along with the CusDec to the Tea Board
- This is in the bottom of the Export CusDec as “**Tea Board**” . When you click on it, the Blend Sheet appears.
- Fill it and submit it. This will go to the Tea Board and confirmation will come to the Customs System.
- At the time of processing, the Key-In-Officer will assess the declaration during processing

Tea Exports

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- Presently this assessment is done only during office hours
- Hence for payments, exporters will have to wait till the CusDec is assessed
